LSSB conductor **Roy Cisneros** is a San Antonio native and graduate of North Texas State University where he received a B.A. in Music Education. He has taught junior and senior high school bands in the Houston area for the past twelve years. Among the honors his bands have received are 1st Division and Outstanding Concert Band awards, numerous jazz band awards and a variety of color guard trophies, including the Texas Color Guard State Champion. Mr. Cisneros has been a member of the Lone Star Symphonic Band for six years and has served as its conductor and music director for the past three.

LSSB conductor emeritus **Andy Mills** is a Ohio native. He received his music training at the Ohio State University and Mannes Conservatory in New York City. He served in the U.S. Navy as instructor at the Navy School of Music in Washington, D.C., and as pianist and conductor of the Navy Band. Mr. Mills moved to Houston in 1972 and subsequently founded the Montrose Singers in 1979, and the Montrose Symphonic Band, now the Lone Star Symphonic Band, in 1980. He is a charter member of the Lesbian and Gay Bands of America. Mr. Mills was named conductor emeritus of the LSSB in 1987.
